## ESSENTIAL BEHAVIORAL NEUROANATOMY

This course will present an overview of brain-behavior relationships relevant to the care of persons with psychiatric and neurological disorders. A neuropsychiatric approach to this material will be used, starting with the premise that all mental functions are brain functions and proceeding thereafter to use recent advances in neuroanatomy, neurochemistry, and neuroimaging to provide clinicians with a working understanding of functional neuroanatomy. The implications of this approach on the use of medications, psychotherapies, and rehabilitation interventions will be emphasized.
